

Gloster House Venue Guide (Simple Tips To Benefit Your Wedding Photos)


Create the ideal location for hair/makeup by making sure you are situated facing one of the three big windows. These spots work lovely in the bridal suite.



Aim to get into your dress with enough time for your photographer to leave for the ceremony 20-30 mins ahead of you.


Have these items ready to photograph: Dress, shoes, flowers, inviations, rings, any other pieces such as jewellery or perfume.





Always face yourself towards the window.

Or try using one of the reception rooms downstairs. This one works a treat!



(The Bridal Suite)

There are many great areas inside the house for groom prep photos but if you want to use one of the bedroooms the Panel room is the best option with it's bright big windows.



Any of the downstairs reception rooms will work perfect for groom prep photos. You can choose which suits your style best.

For outdoor locations it is preferable to have the sun at your back or at your front. For indoor locations it can look nice to have the light coming from the side through a window.

At Gloster House the best positioning most of the day is to either have your ceremony facing the house or directly away from the house for best light.



The best indoor ceremony location is either in the gallery upstairs or the light blue room downstairs. The blue room downstairs however offers better light.

These spaces are also great backup locations for indoor portraits.

The Chapel offers an indoor location for your ceremony with a great amount of natural light. This space can double as a reception space, dance space, or backup location for portraits in bad weather. Very versitile!





## On-site Ceremonies (Best Locations and Positioning)








When considering a top table location choose an area near the brightest spots in the room. Look for the '\*' symbol in these photos for my suggested areas.



For placement of small details always look for clean backgrounds in well lit areas such as this radiator cover which can double as a small table or the above space next to the conservatory.





It's also another ideal backup location for your portraits if it rains!
